- **Please note, the Santa Clarita Optimist Foundation reserves the right to cancel session due to enrollment numbers.** You will be notified if this occurs.
- A parent/guardian **must** attend an **important orientation meeting** on the **Monday, July 13**, from **9:00 - 9:30 a.m.**
- Pick up – please arrive BY 12:30 PM each day. A fee of \$25 will be charged for every 15 minutes you are late.
- Each day your child must wear his/her Safety Town t-shirt and close-toed shoes. Your child may bring a hat and/or sunglasses for the short time we are outdoors. Please put sunscreen (as needed) on your child before entering camp.
- Each day of camp we will provide a healthy snack and bottled water for your child. If your child has a food allergy, please send a healthy and safe snack with your child. Please do not send refillable water bottles with your child.
- All participants must be able to follow simple instructions, work in large and small groups, and independently make transitions between the many Safety Town activities. Transitions from one activity to another occurs about 10 times daily within the 3 ½ hour day. Inappropriate and/or unsafe behavior may be grounds for dismissal from the program. The Safety Town staff, Santa Clarita Optimist Foundation and Optimist International reserve the right to make appropriate adjustments and/or dismiss any student for behavior which poses a safety risk to themselves or others.
- Due to the nature of the Safety Town curriculum and methods of instruction, (e.g., *loud noises, sirens, speakers, verbal commands, vehicle lights, safety masks and apparatus from community safety professionals*), this program may not be suitable for children with sensitivities.
